## **PEBB Changes**

In October the final 2014 premiums will be published in the "For Your Benefit" newsletter. Non-Medicare retirees' premiums are estimated to increase around \$5 for the retiree and \$4 to \$14 more for dependents per month.

Medicare retirees receive a state contribution of \$150 per month toward premiums. The estimated premiums will have slight increases. The Medicare supplement plans, Plan F disabled, and Plan F retired may have a decrease in premiums. These plans do not have a drug benefit. You must have a separate plan for drug coverage.

Watch for your letter in late October that will explain plan options and final premiums. Check for benefit fairs in your area. Usually there is one in Bellingham and one in Mount Vernon. You can ask questions directly to representatives of the medical and dental plans.

Remember, if you wish to change plans, you must do so by November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

If you're on PEBB, it is not necessary to change plans—PEBB is one of the best plans!
