2025 Middle & High School Mini-Grants FAQ

Purpose: To provide an opportunity for **TCSRA members** who are Thurston County public school employees to acquire materials or provide experiences for their students above and beyond what is paid for by district funds. The materials or experiences should supplement and enhance building or district goals.

TCSRA members are eligible for grants of up to \$400.

Where can I get an application? Go to www.wssra-units.org/thurstoncounty/ to find an application to complete and submit online. (The link is on the homepage and will be available on November 1, 2025.) Please note: Food, stickers, toys, trinkets, or fidgets for students are not funded, unless they are integral parts of a units or lessons.

Where should I send my completed application?

Submit your application online from our website: www.wssra-units.org/thurstoncounty/.

What is the due date? Applications must be submitted online by November 30, 2025, for consideration.

When will I know if I am a recipient? If your project is among those selected, you will be notified in December and checks will be distributed in January.
